**What is the congregation's or organization's vision for ministry:**

Our vision is to be a beacon of light giving spiritual and physical support to our congregation, our community, and beyond through the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Spiritually, we have regular scripture-based worship as well as adult, teen, and children's Sunday School. Our women participate in a monthly Presbyterian Women's Circle where they have Bible study and support several Presbyterian Women's outreach programs through special offerings. Our children participate in a summer community-based Vacation Bible School, and several attend our camp within the Presbytery. In a greater effort to fulfill our vision we formed a prayer team and pastoral care committee, both of which focus on the spiritual and physical needs of Christ's church and His people.

While nurturing spiritual needs, we have felt the Holy Spirit moving us to address a variety of physical needs as well. A percentage of our annual budget goes to our mission team, to church camp support, to a caring ministry fund, and to several community outreach programs. We collect money for our local Food Bank and give assistance to our local ministerium and schools, both of which sponsor programs which help the needy.

Members of our congregation as well as their friends give freely of their time, talents, and money to various programs within the church and beyond, hoping that people will see God's light shining through us.

**How do you feel called to reach out to address the emerging needs of your community or constituency:**

We seek to be living examples of Christ's love by serving our neighbors, not rushing to judgment, but asking how we can help. We view mission outreach as an integral part of who we are as we live our faith within our local and global communities.

Besides providing financial resources, we provide manpower. Our "Light Mission Team" has logged over 1000 hours over five trips to New Jersey to help with Super Storm Sandy recovery. Locally, we have worked on refurbishing a Women's Help Center and continue projects for a nonprofit Equine Therapy Center. We have also devoted many hours of work at Pine Springs Camp where our youth attend.

The emerging need to help those affected by drug addiction and recovery has become clear, and we have been participating in a program serving the recovering, which is sponsored by our community ministerium. We also have volunteers who help with our local Food Bank, Library, Women's Club, and Salvation Army. Moving forward, our hope is to achieve more of a presence in our immediate community through increased outreach.

As we have felt called to lay foundations of faith, by serving others, we have grown together, forming lasting friendships with fellow followers of Jesus Christ.

**How will this position help you to reach your vision and mission goals:**

We recognize the need to seek God's direction in all things, so we value a pastor who will keep us focused on the scriptures and prayer; however, we desire more than a "Sunday preacher". We will welcome a pastor who will embrace our vision, meet us where we are, and help us create a strong future.

We accept that our pastor will not be able to do everything. While Trinity has a dedicated team of workers who are eager to be engaged, we need a good "coach". Our pastor will get to know us and our community through everyday encounters, and while caring for our souls will care about conversation and building trusting relationships. He or she will help us discover our gifts and then how to best use these gifts to give spiritual and physical help to others

Through this pastor's spiritual direction and guidance, we will continue to build on our strengths and be inspired to reach out in love to all people. As we are inspired, we wish to be an inspiration to others, young and old, to know God's grace and to be involved in God's work.

He or she should be engaged, well-informed and willing to participate in local activities and concerns of the community.

He or she should be flexible and adaptable, when needs arise, to give support and guidance to congregational members, but also schedule time to care for family and personal needs. As pastor, he or she will provide organizational leadership, motivating and facilitating members to work together on committees and projects.

While staying focused on the vision and uniqueness of our church, this person will guide and unify members of the congregation as we seek together to embrace the possibilities and opportunities for ministry at Trinity. He or she should be confident in speaking and mentoring members of all ages with various issues and be genuine within and outside of the church through the community and beyond.

#### **What specific tasks, assignments, and program areas will this person have responsibility?**

This pastor will be our worship leader and teacher, guiding us through significant events in the life of the church through sermons, Bible study, and prayer. He or she will celebrate the sacraments and officiate at weddings and funerals.

Addressing the needs of our people, this person will provide pastoral care including the sick, the shut-ins, the dying and the grieving, and offer personal counseling to those seeking guidance. The pastor will also be responsible for instruction of prospective new members.

Our pastor will moderate all session meetings, congregational meetings, and support and advise the Standing Committees of Session (Buildings and Grounds, Christian Education, Fellowship, Finance, Mission, Worship), and oversee the administration of the congregation's work.

As head of staff, he or she will oversee staff members so that all duties of the church are performed in an efficient, congenial manner.

Trinity's pastor will participate in the community ministerium and stay connected to Presbytery.
