We have had a healthy preschool program that has served the community for more than 40 years. We have had a long and visible history in the community for over two centuries. There has been room for all to feel the presence of God's love here on earth since 1778. We give thanks for the past and present God-given gifts and Rehoboth resources, and are prayerful with hope for new ways to express our vision. We recognize the changing times of churches and are willing, committed and eager to engage, motivate, and grow, to proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ.

How do you feel called to reach out to address the emerging needs of your community or constituency:

Rehoboth is caring and passionate about helping others in our community, our state and around the world. We are active supporters of Redstone Presbytery's missional partnerships in South Sudan.

Our Deacons work tirelessly with fundraising so they are able to help others as Jesus taught us. We have been able to give to the following in 2017: Rostraver Food Bank (monthly), Washington Twp./Fayette City Food Bank, Blackburn Center, Reality Tour, Church World Services, Presbyterian Disaster Relief Fund, City Mission in Washington County, Belle Vernon Area School Food Service Dept. for Elementary Students Cafeteria Accts, Salvation Army, Gift Cards to College Students, American Cancer Society, Alzheimer's Association, American Diabetes Association, ALS Society.

We ship care packages to troops and Rehoboth family members who are serving overseas, and also to camp counselors at Pine Springs Camp. We have a Women's Group, Vacation Bible School, Rostraver Food Bank volunteers each month, host Boy and Girl Scout meetings, and the Mon Valley Men's Dart Ball League.

We provide comfort and support to our church members and families by preparing and serving funeral luncheons. We mail the Home Touch Quarterly and Sunday Bulletins to our home-bound members and college students to sustain their spiritual needs and to help them stay connected to Rehoboth.

Our members are very giving at Christmas when they purchase items to give to children through the Salvation Army Christmas tags program.
