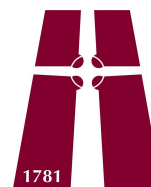

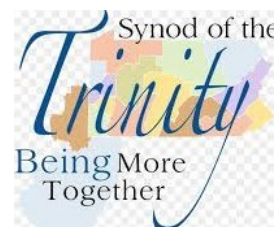
orders will be August 2, 2021 in order to have them for distribution at the September meeting. Thank you!
