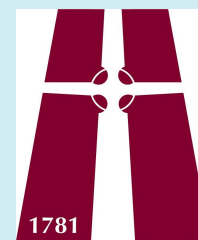

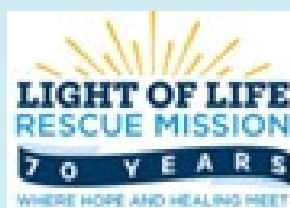

NEW! A CONFIRMATION CURRICULUM for the Matthew 25 Church - How do we stem the tide of young people leaving the church, not for



the sake of improved numbers and full worship services but for the sake of the world that God loves?

Commissioned to Change the World: Confirmation for the Matthew 25 Congregation, written by Mark D. Hinds, marries adolescent confirmation with the theological focus of “serving the least of these.” The curriculum affirms teenagers as God’s beloved children, anointed for ministry in the context of a covenant community of mutual encouragement and accountability.

Amen to Action – Since 2017, “Amen to Action” has been packing meals for the Greater Pittsburgh Community Food Bank. In 2021, the event was moved to ten different churches in the Pittsburgh region.
