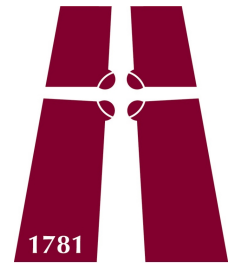

"Seeing Jesus Again"- Reflections from the EP



Over Christmas time, our family decided to do some major "housecleaning" of boxes of materials that we had accumulated over time. As I opened one shabby box, I discovered a "treasure" of old pictures and memorabilia from my "days" originating in grade school and extending through college (*of course, to my family's chagrin, all of it must be kept*). As I retrieved each item from the container, an award or a memento or a picture would be revealed and proudly displayed to my family. Each of these "important" items would spark the recounting of various stories to my sons who sat nearby (*who feigned a little bit of interest to placate me*☺).

During those moments of walking the paths of "memory lane," periodically, I would hand them a group picture and ask them to "pick" me out of the group. While in my own mind, I don't think I have changed a bit, let me just say that many times they found it at least challenging, if not difficult. To them, these were pictures of some younger person who was disconnected or at least distant from the person they knew as their father. Yet, while these images may not "tell the whole story," certainly they and their accompanying stories have not only shaped my identity, but the person whom they have only known as their dad.
