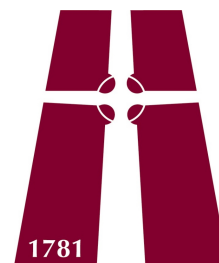

Sunday School is over. What can we do to keep the kids coming to the church? At Level Green PC, we are blessed to have a great library and a committee that keeps it current. Roian Koerber has been the driving force in the area of the library. We have two weekly programs to utilize it. They are both early on Tuesday mornings. That way, the families can still go swimming or whatever else they have planned for the day. But, they start Tuesdays at LGPC.

Story Hour is for those age 4 through entering 1st Grade. There was a time when we had two groups - age 4 through Kindergarten and 1st Grade through 3rd Grade. But, those were the good old days! Each Tuesday, there is a different volunteer who reads the stories, leads them in crafts, songs, a dance, a game, or maybe shows a DVD. It is different each Tuesday. The story is the main focus and is always read in the library. We also have a youth helper each week. Their main tasks are to assist the leader, move the children from one room to another, and to help the children choose books or DVDs to borrow for the week.

Son Seekers is for those entering 2nd Grade through 5th Grade. I never turn away someone who is going into the Middle School. Sometimes they just need a little more time before moving on to the Youth activities. I lead this group each week. We start with a game and once everyone has arrived, we move into the lesson. The lesson is always based on a passage of Scripture. This summer the theme is Parables. I try to have something interactive each week. We might have a skit, do a role play, do a science experiment, compete in groups to complete a worksheet or task, or maybe we'll take a field trip to a labyrinth. And, there is always a snack! The last five minutes of the class we go to the library to choose a book or two. That also gives me a chance to meet with the parents of the younger group.

We also host a **Wet, Wild Wednesday** one evening. It's very wet and very wild! I try to schedule it close to the end of summer. Janet Battenhouse has been helping me for years. We have fallen into a routine that both Janet and I like. We do as much as possible outside on the lawn. We lead dry games as the children (Kindergarten through 5th Grade) assemble. We move into a Bible lesson with an activity; then comes the snack! Once we set some guidelines, the wet games begin and it usually includes a Slip N Slide. At the end of the evening we have a closing prayer. The last activity is a water balloon battle with all the leftover water balloons. Both Janet and I are willing participants and the kids love getting us wet. They even make a game of cleaning up the balloon pieces on the lawn before they head home.

Of course, all programs are open to the community and free. In fact, we have more non-members than members attending the summer programs.
