

WHAT IS THE PRESBYTERIAN SCHOLARSHIP FUND?

The Presbyterian Scholarship Fund was established in 1843 to provide scholarships for Presbyterian students at seven Presbyterian related colleges within Western Pennsylvania, Ohio, and West Virginia. Board members are elected from eight presbyteries from the western half of the Synod of the Trinity to manage and develop the funds necessary to provide financial aid to qualified students. Using proceeds from current investments, the fund provides \$33,600 in aid annually for 28 students. The board recently began an active campaign to secure new gifts that will enable more scholarships to be awarded.

WHAT PRESBYTERIAN SCHOLARSHIP FUND PROVIDES

The Fund provides to freshman students who

- **Need:** have demonstrated financial need. Need eligibility is determined by the financial aid office of the college.
- **Church Affiliation:** are members of a congregation of the Presbyterian Church (USA) within the bounds of the following presbyteries: Beaver-Butler, Kiskiminetas, Lake Erie, Pittsburgh, Redstone, Shenango, Upper Ohio Valley, and Washington.
- **College:** have been accepted for admission to and enrollment in a full course of study leading to a degree at one of the following

Participating Colleges:

- College of Wooster
- Davis and Elkins
- Grove City
- Muskingum
- Washington and Jefferson
- Waynesburg
- Westminster

The scholarship is renewable provided the student meets the school's requirements for continued eligibility. \$1,400 per year can be awarded for four years at one of these seven schools.
